

Dear SPBA Members,

The SPBA would like to update all of our members on the COVID-19 pandemic and how it is affecting our Southern Peninsula Basketball community.

In relation to Social Distancing, further restrictions have been put in place by the Australian Government, as of 23/3/20. The parts of this that direct the Southern Peninsula Basketball community directly are;

## Restrictions on facilities

The following facilities are restricted from opening from midday local time 23 March 2020:

- Pubs, registered and licensed clubs (excluding bottle shops attached to these venues), hotels (excluding accommodation).
- Gyms and indoor sporting venues.
- Cinemas, entertainment venues, casinos and night clubs.
- Restaurants and cafes will be restricted to takeaway and/or home delivery.
- Religious gatherings, places of worship or funerals (in enclosed spaces and other than very small groups and where the 1 person per 4 square metre rule applies).

Isolated remote community hubs are not included in these restrictions.

Other facilities are not impacted, but could be considered under a later stage of restrictions, if necessary. These measures also apply to outdoor spaces associated with the above venues.

These restrictions apply to our community. Our facilities are closed and are not accessible, nor are the outdoor spaces associated with our facilities.

We understand that it is quiet challenging and difficult for everyone, for many different reasons during these times. The SPBA implores our community to do what has been asked by our Government in relation to Social Distancing.
