



OUTDOOR 3X3 SEASON REGISTRATION INFORMATION

The Southern Peninsula Basketball Association are offering an outdoor 3x3 competition as a part of our staged return to competitions after the COVID-19 enforced lay off.

This competition will run for 3 consecutive Saturday's,
Saturday November 14th, 21st & 28th, 2020.

Due to government restrictions and court availability this competition will be offered to junior age groups U10, U12s and U14s.

All teams will have 3-4 games of 10 minutes each day.

(Note: Competitions running are subject to the amount of team entries per age group and weather permitting.)

Players who are wishing to play and do not have a team can register their interest individually and SPBA will endeavour to create teams where possible or assign players to teams needing more players.

Each team can register a minimum of 3 players and a maximum of 4 players.

All players who take the court **must** be registered and insured, no exceptions. SPBA need to have all player information of those playing to ensure contact tracing can occur if any situations arise.

All coaches/team contacts must have a valid Working With Children Check.

**In addition to this document, please read the SPBA Return to Play document for all of the changes that have occurred as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic. This includes venue entry requirements, game payments, sanitising procedures and facility safety.*

TEAM ENTRIES

All 3x3 team and player registrations are to be done via the new Play HQ platform. This has replaced SportsTG.

Step 2.

- Each player, coach and team manager, must register online with their own active email address.
- Play HQ accounts will need to be created for all first time registrations.

PLAYER REGISTRATIONS DUE:

Friday 13th of November, 2020 at 5:00pm

Teams will not be permitted to play until a minimum of three players have registered.

All players who take the court must be registered and insured, no exceptions.

SPBA need to have all player information of those playing every night to ensure contact

tracing can occur if any situations arise.

Fixtures will be made available online Tuesday 10th of November.

All fixtures are subject to change and we recommend not printing off the website.

BASKETBALL VICTORIA LICENSE (includes insurance)

All members who had a current BV license from playing in the Summer 2020 season will still be covered under this as their license period has been extended by Basketball Victoria for the period of the COVID-19 restrictions preventing basketball. Please ensure you enter your first name, surname and date of birth the as it appears on the Summer 2020 registration. This will pick up if you have paid already and it will not charge you. Otherwise the fee will be as per below:

Junior Insurance/Licence costs:

\$25.00 per junior player (U18y/o), annually.

This will cover participants for a 12 months period, from the date of purchase or from the start of the season (if this date is later).

This will not need to be paid again upon registering to upcoming domestic registrations.

PRIVACY INFORMATION

By lodgement and payment of registration for the coming season, you authorise the use by the SPBA of your name, fame, image, likeness, voice, visual portrayal and reputation in the context of the sport for the purpose of advertising, promotion and marketing the sport of basketball.

MEMBER PROTECTION BY-LAWS

All team managers and coaches of all junior teams are required to have a valid working with children's check (unless exempt) **and** statutory declaration.

After grading, any team that fails to meet these obligations may result in a 0-20 forfeit for each game played until rectified.

Your team manager and/or may be asked to show proof of their Working With Children's Check by SPBA staff at any time during the season.

3x3 RULES SIMPLIFIED

TEAM ROSTER	Total of 4 players <ul style="list-style-type: none">• 3 on court at any one time• 1 substitution
INITIAL POSSESION	Rock/Paper/Scissors <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Winner decides who starts with possession
SCORING	Inside 3 point arc = 1 point Outside 3 point arc = 2 points
GAME TIMING & SCORING	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• 1 x 10 minute period• Running clock• Score limit of 21 points
TIME OUTS	1 x 30 second time out per team
OVERTIME	First team to score 2 points wins
FREE THROWS ON SHOOTING FOUL	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Inside the arc = 1 free throw• Outside the arc = 2 free throws

FOUL LIMIT BONUS & PENALTIES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Limit 6 team fouls • Fouls 7, 8 & 9 = 2 free throws • Fouls 10+ = 2 free throws plus possession
JUMP BALLS	Ball given to defence beyond the arc
ACTION AFTER STEALS & DEFENSIVE REBOUNDS	Ball to be dribbled/passed beyond the arc to become offence
DEAD BALL	Ball exchanged beyond the arc
SUBSTITUTIONS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Subs can be made on any dead ball • Exiting player must step off the court before the sub is allowed on • No action is required by the referee

GAME DAY INFORMATION

SCORING

Each team must provide one competent scorer for all games. The scorer must be 14 years of age or older.

CONTACT FREE GAME PAYMENT

\$7.00 per player to be paid via EFTPOS only

SOCIAL DISTANCING AND SPECTATOR REQUIREMENTS

Each child is limited to 1 parent, guardian or carer only.

Face masks – worn if desired by participants, all other patrons as per Government requirements.

No hand shaking or high fives.

Maximum of 1 coach or team official per team.

Rosebud Primary School toilets are unavailable for public use, public toilets located close by

are to be used instead. Please check with venue staff for further information.
Please follow required 1.5 metre socially distancing whilst attending 3x3 competitions.
