The High Performance Coach will work closely with the Director of Coaching to develop the Southern Peninsula pathway and to achieve the objectives of the SPBA Strategic Plan.

Key Responsibilities

High Performance Program

- Actively identify and develop athletes from within the clubs through the Southern Peninsula High Performance Program. Developing a program including weekly workouts, video review, individual performance plans and assistance as required for their level. Implementing a Long-Term Athletic Development (LTAD) mindset is a critical part to the development of athletes through the Southern Peninsula pathway
- Mentor athletes selected to Basketball Australia and Basketball Victoria high performance programs in both 3x3 and 5x5 streams. Assisting them with appropriate planning, education and workouts relevant to their workload and level
- Work alongside the SPBA Director of Coaching to ensure teachings align with the Sharks Style of Play
- Be active within Basketball Victoria's High-Performance Programs to remain at the forefront of the latest teachings
- Attend representative games periodically
- Working with Basketball Victoria, seek feedback and assist in the development of athletes through Basketball Victoria and Basketball Australia pathways
- Work alongside the SPBA Director of Coaching & Basketball Victoria coaches to ensure adequate periodisation of athletes.

- Attend one National Junior Championships annually (if in Victoria) providing SPBA representation
- Liaise with Marketing to promote High Performance aspects of the club including selections, education and highlights
- Meet with the General Manager on a fortnightly basis and provide a satisfactory written report once a month which will be sent to the Board of Management
- Ensure that all facilities are safe to use before training and games and in situations that they are not, take necessary actions to ensure they are. In your absence, holding coaches accountable to the same requirements.

• Monitor and evaluate the SPBA Strategic Plan, Annual Work Plans and Performance Indicators related to High Performance based activities.
