Purpose

The Youth League Women Head Coach will work alongside the Senior Women Head Coach to develop and sustain a strong core group of athletes and coaching staff to compete in the Big V Competition. Whilst building a pathway for our Junior Representative and Youth League athletes, this position must have a clear holistic vision of now and the future.

This position works closely under the Senior Women Head Coach to build the Senior Women's Program. Ensuring both teams run the same system and work together at trainings is an important part of this role.

Key Responsibilities

Work with the Senior Women's Team Head Coach to:

- Recruit suitably experienced players and team staff to the program to enhance the core playing group
- Conduct an extensive pre-season for the upcoming season including training and practice matches
- Implementation of the Sharks Style of Play
- Develop the core playing group with a focus on developing our own
- Work in collaboration with the Director of Coaching to assist in building a connection between our junior programs to our senior representative teams.

The Youth League Women Head Coach will:

- Run a minimum of four hours of team training per week
- Attend all fixtured Youth League Women games
- Attend all fixtures Senior Women games where games do not clash
- Prepare and present weekly video reviews for the team
- Conduct at least two reviews for each member of the playing group including video review
- Prepare and execute a weekly written and video scout of opposing team and players
- Attend Big V club functions
